Armchair Astronauts
Pay Visit to the Moon

A simulated "soft landing" through space, on the rugged terrain of the lunar surface will be made by audiences during presentations of "A Trip to the Moon" at Griffith Park Observatory's planetarium theater.

Dr. Clarence H. Clemmshaw, director at the Los Angeles City Recreation and Parks Department facility, said photos taken during recent space flights and paintings by Chesley Bonestell will be projected on the theater's 75-foot domed ceiling to produce a sensation of actually blasting off and traveling

After the landing, armchair astronauts will explore the lunar surface and view the earth as it rotates on its axis and passes through phases similar to the moon's.

Dr. Clemmshaw said the Observatory is open seven days a week during the summer months. Shows are presented at 3, 8, and 9:15 p.m. Extra presentations are scheduled at 1:30 and 4:30 p.m. on weekends. The current show and the summer schedule will continue through Sept. 11.
