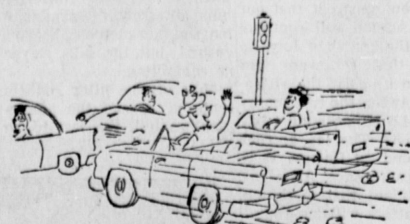

Aid Asked In Study Of Slides

A bill asking the Secretary of the Army to begin a study of landslides and flood control in Los Angeles County has been introduced in the House of Representatives in Washington, D.C.

Representative Alphonzo Bell (R-28th District) introduced the new legislation, which seeks to authorize the Secretary of the Army to make the studies through the Chief of Engineers. The study would be made with the cooperation of the U. S. Geological Survey and the Department of the Interior.

Bell asked that landslides soil erosion, surface and subsurface drainage conditions, flood control, and seismic disturbances in the Pacific Palisades be studied.

The Congressman expressed concern about extensive damage caused by land slippage in the past, as well as possible future damage. "The City of Los Angeles has provided emergency work after slides and is studying land disturbances in order to recommend preventive action," Bell said. "Yet, local and state efforts are inadequate not through lack of will or talent, but because of the magnitude of the problem."

Bell said federal assistance is "mandatory, for neither the city nor the state have money or resources to provide protection to individuals residing in danger areas."
