Daily Business Bulletin Now Available at Chamber

Torrance business firms may now consult the "Commerce Business Daily" at the offices of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce, 1510 Cravens Ave.

As part of the service rendered by the chamber as a cooperative office of the U.S. Department of Commerce, the local office maintains a file of the bulletin, which is published five days each week.

The "Daily," an information bulletin for businessmen, provides a daily list of U.S. Government procurement invitations, subcontracting leads, contract awards, sales of surplus property, and foreign business opportunities.

PROCUREMENT invitations cover many areas, including experimental, development, test and research work; maintenance and repair of equipment; architect, engineer, expert and consultant services; housekeeping services; photographic, mapping, printing and publication services; transportation services; construction and other improvements, such as, roads, bridges, tunnels, sewers, power lines, docks, railways, and canals.

Report on Un-American Activities Now Ready

The 13th annual report of James D. Driscoll, Chief Clerk of the Assembly, Suite 3165, Assembly Chambers, State Capitol, Sacramento 14.

COPIES OF BILLS introduced at the special session of the State Legislature may be obtained from the Legislative Bill Room, Room 215, State Capitol, Sacramento 14, Chapel said.

Persons writing for copies of bills should give the number and the author's name and the session of the legislature at which it was introduced. The budget bill is not available, Chapel said.

The assemblyman said it would be difficult to obtain bills introduced prior to the 1965 session.

THE ASSEMBLYMAN also listed several other free publications which may be obtained.

"Basic Facts of Firearms Control," a publication of the National Rifle Association, may be obtained by writing to the Legislative Service, National Rifle Association of America, 1600 Rhode Island, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20036.

The pamphlet, according to Chapel, includes a summary of federal and state laws regulating the possession and use of firearms. "I highly recommend this publication to anyone who has an interest in firearms legislation," Chapel said.

COPIES OF THE book, "Constitution of the United States and of the State of California and Related Documents" once again are available, he said. The related documents include the Declaration of Independence, the Magna Carta, the Mayflower Compact, and other historical writings.
