A Bowler's Starting Position

(This is the first of seven articles on Bowling)

Assuming that you are properly dressed for bowling and that you have a ball that is fitted to your hand and one you can control, you are ready to start bowling. The first thing you should do is to determine your starting position.

To find your starting position, I suggest that you go to the foul line and place your heels two or three inches from the foul line. Now walk back four natural steps, take another half step to allow for your slide, turn around facing the pins and that is your starting position. Star

bowlers call this the "point of origin," and regardless of what lane, in what establishment, or in what city you might be, the point of origin will always remain the same. You might have to modify it a few inches or so, at first, but once you have found your point of origin, it should never change. Notice the star bowlers on television and you'll see that the first place a bowler looks after he picks up his ball is at his starting point.

In recommending a stance position, I suggest you keep your feet placed together with left foot slightly forward of right, knees bent, ball held waist high and in line with right shoulder, with the elbow tucked in closely to side of body. The wrist should be fairly straight and the thumb between 10 and 11 o'clock.

Teen Bowlers Compete in Tournament

The sixth annual singles championships for prep and junior division bowlers is under way at all Southland bowling centers. This event is open to boys and girls 12 years or under as of June 1 and junior boys and girls, ages 13-15. The major division championships were held last month.

House qualifying is on a continuing basis through Saturday.

A third of each division will participate in the Southern California finals Aug. 13 at a site to be announced.

This event, on a handicap basis, is open to all youth bowlers.

Magner to Head Study Committee

Dr. W. Bruce Magner Jr., a curriculum consultant for the Torrance Unified School District, has been named chairman of a committee to evaluate Garey High School in Pomona.

Dr. Magner will head a committee of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) April 17 through 19, 1967. The group will evaluate the school to determine if it meets current standards for accredited high schools.

Green Fee Increased at Public Golf Courses in County

Reluctantly acceding to the suggestion of the city council and the city administrative officer, the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Commission last Thursday voted an increase of 50 cents per round for 18-hole golf courses and 25 cents per pound for

all regulation nine-hole and three special courses, effective August 1.

The City Council reduced the department's appropriation for 1966-1967 as submitted by Mayor Yorty by \$300,000 and proposed an increase in greens fees to make

up the deficit. The city administrative officer concurred in this recommendation.

The Commission pointed out, however, that prices charged for play on Los Angeles City courses are below those charged by courses of

comparable caliber and quality of maintenance. It noted also that greens fees have not increased since 1957 despite the fact that cost of operation, including labor, have risen substantially.

A recent study by H. B. Maynard Company, management consultants, recom-

mended a general increase in fees and a higher rate for weekend play. The Commission flatly rejected raising weekend fees above those charged Monday through Friday, on the theory that it would place an unfair burden on golfers who can only play on weekends.
