Sam Schauerman Jr., administrative intern for the past year at El Camino College, has been named dean of the college's Division of Physical Sciences.

Schauerman, 37, succeeds William T. Mooney Jr., who resigned to return to full-time teaching at the college.

PRIOR TO coming to El Camino in the fall of 1965, Schauerman served as dean of students and registrar at Otero Junior College in La Junta, Colo., a position he had held since 1961. He joined the Otero faculty in 1957 as mathematics and physics instructor. sics instructor.

The new dean will serve on a half-time basis until September in order to complete work as consultant to a state work as consultant to a state study group working with the problem of conservation of California's sand and gravel resources in conjunc-tion with the Assembly Com-mittee on Public Utilities and


