He said the CREA Home Trade-In Conference is scheduled for Aug. 8 in Coronado, Aug. 9 in Anaheim; Aug. 10 in Burbank, Aug. 11 in Sacramento, and Aug. 12 in San Jose.

Jerome Blank, realtor of Albany, conference chairman, said that he and four other realtors with heavy experience in trade-ins will address the group.

"TRADING is one of the bright spots in the tight money market," Blank said. "People want to buy and they are well able to, so the demand and capability are there. It's only the squeeze on sources of financing that

gets in their way. That's why the realtor who can work out a home trade-in is earning the gratitude of his clients and finds business better than ever, in spite of tight money."
