Chace, Hahn Exchange Words Over Watts Plan

Supervisor Burton W. Chace today said there is no similarity between the financing proposed for the Watts area hospital and that used to finance the Torrance County Courts Building under construction.

His statement followed a decision by the Board of Supervisors yesterday to proceed with planning for the hospital, even though the method of financing has not been determined.

Chace said he supports the hospital, but objects to going outside for financing that project.

HIS POSITION was attacked by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, who said time and time again Chace and the board have found ways to finance projects in Chace's district when bond issues were rejected.

Hahn specifically cited the Torrance facility, the Marina del Rey development, and the Long Beach County Courts Building.

"I can't understand why Mr. Hahn would attack the Torrance project," Chace said. "It was financed by County Retirement Funds and is within his district."

RECENT district realignments have placed the facility, now under construction, in Hahn's second district. Chace still represents the southern section of Torrance.

"As to other projects in my district, only three are scheduled to be built with funds other than budgeted money or a bond issue approved by the voters—and those are to be financed by County Retirement Funds."

Chace said the Marina del Rey was financed by bonds approved by the voters, and the Long Beach County Courts Building was budgeted over a six year period.

"There is a need for a hospital in Watts," he said. "I would not want my opposition to the proposed financing to reflect opposition to the hospital itself."

"However, the voters turned down a bond issue only last June, and it seems unethical for the Board of Supervisors to overrule the wishes of the voters."
