Land for Hospital Purchased

Formal purchase of the 30-brace site for the new Watts fospital has been announced his week by Supervisor Ken-heth Hahn. Hahn said the purchase by the county at "bargain rates" is the "most significant step taken by the Board of Super-visors in making this vitally needed hospital a reality." Although the land at 120th street and Wilmington avenue is currently valued at approx-imately \$30,000 an acre, the county was able to obtain it for one-tenth that amount, slightly above \$3,000 an acre, under terms of a 1945 agree-ment, Hahn explained.
