Teenagers Earn Money, Hold 'Painting Party'

Armed with two gallons of paint, paint brushes, rollers, and buckets, the daring group—along with their sponsor, Frank Bounds, a d Mrs. Sandovich set to work to restyle their young people's room.

Painting the room wasn't the only reason behind the work. According to Mrs. Peter Sandovich, the project's main goal was "to give the teachers and the kids a better opportunity to get to know each other personally." Not only did the teens paint the rooms themselves, but they paid for everything, earning money washing windows, trimming lawns and trees, and the girls helped raise money by babysitting. Neither the church nor the

teachers paid for anything. It wasn't all work for the volunteers. There were trips to the beach AFTER the painting sessions. The first morning the troop arrived at 7 o'clock with the boys doing most of the painting and the girls helping out with refreshments, but last week the girls got into the act and it was every man for himself. What about the results? Well, the room did get painted, but the most important outcome of all was that there is at last "some communication between the teachers and the kids," Mrs. Sandovich said.
