Make a lengthwise cut bi inch deep on top of each roll and open slightly or make 2 cuts across roll. Dip bottom of each roll in vel-¹⁵ Inch deep on top of each roll and open slightly or make 2 cuts across roll. Dip bottom of each roll in yel-low cornmeal and place on a greased baking sheet. Let rise in a warm place (60 degrees to 150 degrees) or until tripled in bulk. Bake 400 degrees for 10 minutes. Brush well with egg white which has been mixed with water. Bake 5 to 10 minutes.
