

Garden Checklist

- Plant herbs from small nursery containers for greater pleasure in your outdoor barbecue area.
- Dig and divide Bearded Iris, if you haven't done so in the past three years. Enrich the soil before planting.
- Water young fruit trees more often than you do the older established trees. This goes for all newly planted shrubs and trees.
- Water camellias and azaleas by overhead sprinkling. They require less water at their roots when their leaves are frequently soaked.
- Shasta daisies and other perennials may be divided any time from now through fall.

Compton May Oppose Plan Of New City

Opposition by the city of Compton to the northern boundary of the proposed city of Dominguez has been recommended to the Compton City Council.

Harry Scott, Compton city manager, has asked councilmen to protest the proposed northern boundary at a hearing before the Local Agency Formation Commission Wednesday, Sept. 21.

Councilman Lionel Cade last month said the proposed boundary would leave an industrial island of the proposed new city north of the Artesia Freeway when that route is completed. Compton would have no control over the zoning of the area, Cade said, and it would be adjacent to a residential area in Compton.
