The court test will come
because of a unique situation
in Sacramento County which
is attracting statewide and
national publicity. The new
elected assessor of that county has said that she will assess all property at 100 per
cent of its full value because
our California Constitution
requires her to do so. The
storm which her proposal has
aroused is certain to have a
considerable influence on our
work on property faxation at
the 1967 session.

As the autiority behind
her decision, she cites Section 12 of Article XI of the
Constitution, which states,
"All property subject to taxation shall be assessed for
taxation at its full cash
value". But opponents of her
idea quote another section of
the Constitution as supporting the present practice. Section 1 of Article XII states
in part, "All property in the
State... shall be taxed in
proportion to its value, to be
ascertained as provided by
law."

THE CONSTERNATION caused by the assessor's proposal was widespread. From offices of the State Board of Equalization came word that if she were to put her idea into practice there are two legal methods the Board could use to roll back her assessments.
