John Shelton, music director at the church, will conduct the Del Amo Baptist Choir.

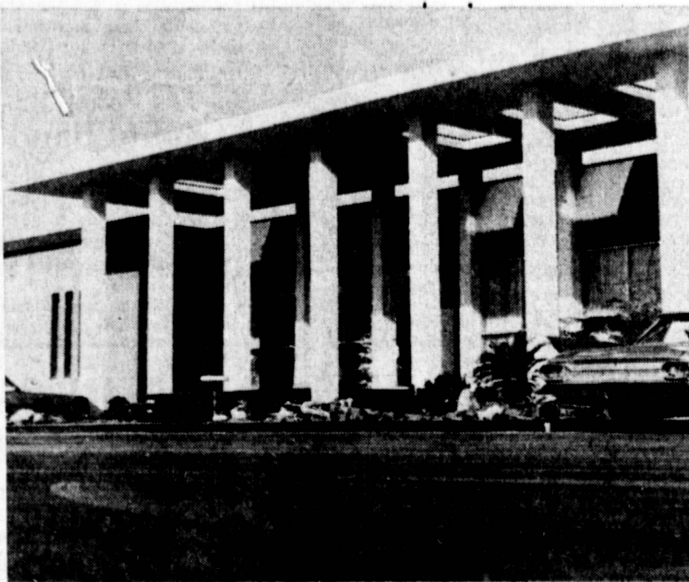
Radio broadcasts of each of the performances is scheduled.
