

Fire Site To Be Sold At Auction

The site of the old Carson Fire Station, 404 E. Carson St., will be sold at public auction, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced today.

Hahn pointed out the station has been replaced by a modern new facility for engine and rescue companies Number 36 at 223rd and Main streets.

Hahn said the decision to auction the property, appraised by the County Engineer at \$32,500, was made after it was determined that the lot was not required for development in long-range planning. The property is rectangular in shape, 75 by 150 feet, zoned M-1. It contains approximately 11,250 square feet.

The abandoned 19-year-old, one-story station building will be sold with the site.

The auction will be held Sept. 24 in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room in downtown Los Angeles.

Minimum bid will be \$32,500.

State Gets \$76 Million In Receipts

SACRAMENTO — California's cash receipts for the first month of the 1967-68 fiscal year totaled \$76 million, an increase of 12 per cent over a year ago, State Controller Houston Flournoy announced today.

Expenditures for the same period, however, amounted to \$236 million, an increase of 16.9 per cent.

To foot the August bills, the general fund will have to borrow some \$160 million from the pooled money account.

Dorothy Digs

Most home gardeners like to have sweet peas in bloom for Christmas. If you live in a frost-free area, this is the time to sow the seed in order to accomplish this feat. Give the plants a location in full sun and sow the seed in a well-prepared soil by using leafmold or clean compost along with steer manure. The support for the vines should be erected before the seed is sown.

One of the most destructive pests with sweet peas is the wireworm. This pest will start working on the seed as soon as the seed softens up after sowing. The young plants will get to be about five or six inches high then topple over.

The best control for wireworms, also centipedes and certain fungi found in the soil is a product containing copper ether solution. This is applied to the soil before sowing. It can also be used safely around growing plants.

Feeding your sweet peas with an all-fish liquid fertilizer will give you prize-winning blooms.
