After tuning up for the 1967 season at last week's Long Beach Invitational, El Camino's cross country team opens its regular season schedule against Palomar College in San Diego, Friday at 3:30 p.m.

The Warriors enter the Metropolitan Conference race next week, hoping to improve last year's fifth place finish, and 2-7 overall record.

The Warriors go to Rio Hondo for a three-way meet that includes Valley.

In last week's invitational, Palomar finished second place and was paced by Randy Hartman, who copped individual honors with a winning time of 20:06 over the 3.5 mile course.

Second-year coach Bob Myers divided the EC squad into an "A" and "B" team for the invitational. The Warriors placed seventh and ninth in the large JC and frosh division.

Anchored by Lenny Jay, EC's top finisher at 23:00, the "A" team trailed Metro Conference opponents Long Beach and Cerritos which placed fifth and sixth.

Despite the finish, El Camino had a finger in the winner's circle as the USC frosh captured first place in the 13-team field. Aiding the Trojans' cause was the fourth place finish of Jeff Marsee, a former teammate of Jay's at South High.

Marsee is the son of Dr. Stuart E. Marsee, president of El Camino College.
