

Garden Checklist

- 1. When planting bulbs, overplant them with annuals such as alyssum, Virginia Stock or violas so that all bloom at the same time.
2. Plant fairy primrose now for winter bloom.
3. Cool weather vegetables may be planted now.
4. Plant anemone and ranunculus bulbs now.
5. Be sure chrysanthemums are well staked to support the weight of blooms.
