# New Rule Bars Liquor Salesmen's

A SPOKESMAN for the department said the entertainment policy statement, recently sent to members of the industry, was "pretty much a restatement of past policy, with perhaps a little tightening up." He said excesses in entertainment were considered "some form of commercial bribery."

The policy statement said entertainment would be limited to one account at a time—that is a wholesaler could entertain only one retailer at a time, or a distiller could entertain only one wholesaler. It also specified that the person entertained had to be authorized and legally qualified to engage in sales or purchase transactions.

The statement had cast some doubts on the legality of a distiller or wholesaler setting.

The statement had cast some doubts on the legality of distiller or wholesaler setting up a hospitality room at an industry convention. However, the department spokesman said a convention was considered to be a "very special circumstance" and the policy would not prevent such hospitality rooms.

OTHERS questioned whether the limit of entertainment to one account at a time would prevent lunches given for retailers by wholesalers of by distillers for wholesalers. "If there's a mass meeting to introduce a new product. I don't think the department would question it," the department spokesman said. "However, if it is just a routine way to put on a feed, with plenty of free booze, to take care of steady customers, the department would take a hard look at it."
