Mrs. Marvin Scott, South Bay area council president, will conduct the pledge ritual.

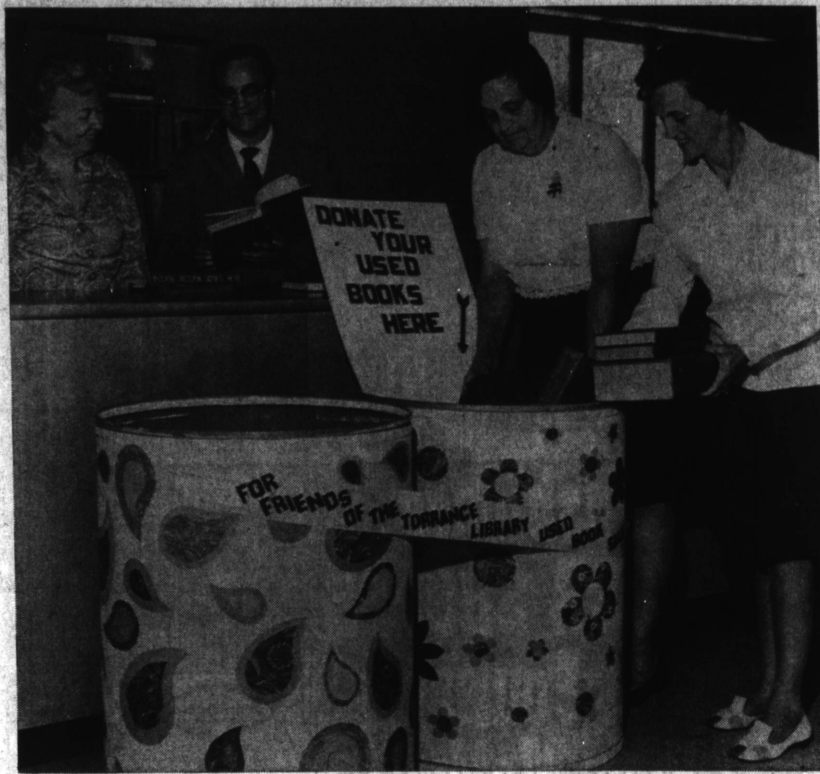

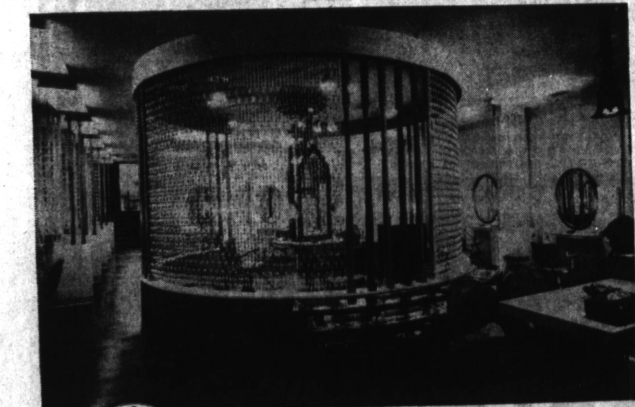
