

Watson Refinery Tours Scheduled

Atlantic Richfield Co. announced today that it will inaugurate a public tour program at its Watson Refinery where, in recent months, the company has put into operation some of the most sophisticated processes of petroleum refining.

A two-year, \$60 million improvement program was completed earlier this year.

"Watson Refinery began operations in 1924, but continual improvements in equipment have left little resemblance to the original plant," said L. F. Strader, vice president of manufacturing for the Richfield Division. "The tours will give the public an interesting and informative exposure to production processes for gasoline and other petroleum products used daily by all of us."
