CHP Adds Speakers To Cars

If you are driving along the highway and a Highway Patrol car begins to talk to you, don't be alarmed. Pay attention, however, because the message might save you a great deal of trouble.

The patrol is now equipping some of its autos with outside public address systems which will allow its officers to communicate easily with the drivers of other cars, according to Highway Patrol Captain P. J. Ford, commander of the South Los Angeles area.

About 200 cars are now equipped with the system and an additional 300 will be equipped later. The cars are spread throughout the state, but there is a concentration of them on Interstate 80 and U.S. 50 between Sacramento and the Nevada State line.

CAPTAIN FORD said patrol commanders on the highways over the Sierra Nevada Mountains have told him "the outside speaker has been a valuable aid during storm situations when information about road conditions must be given to a greater number of cars in a short time."

Another part of this new system is a different sounding siren. The patrol cars will still be equipped with the usual sounding siren but in addition will have a siren which varies from a high to a low pitch. This will be used to get attention if a motorist is not responding to the sound of the regular siren. It is only a supplement to the normal siren.
