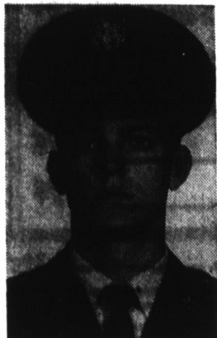


**LAURA L. McFARLANE**

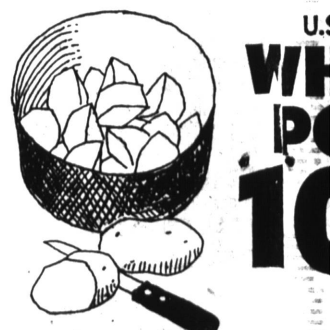

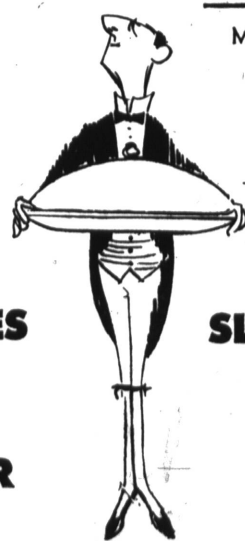
