# Garden Checklist Obedience

1. Fuchsias may be pruned anytime during the next two or three weeks. Like roses, they bloom on new growth and can stand rather severe pruning.

2. Right now during bare root planting season is the most economical time to buy roses, fruit trees, berries, shade trees and many deciduous flowering shrubs.

3. Feed cyclamen as you would begonias-with liquid fish fertilizer. Potted plants need more frequent feeding and watering than do those in the open ground.

4. Many overwintering insects and pests can be eliminated right now by a thorough winter spraying. Also spray peach trees now to control leaf curl. Another spray will be needed when buds begin to
