

# Teeth Tell Us Much About Man of Today and History

(This is one of a series of articles on dental health prepared by the Harbor Dental Society, an affiliate of the American Dental Association.)

Your teeth may tell more about you than you know.

Everyone has heard of how dental clues have been used to identify the remains of victims of airplane crashes or other disasters. The FBI regularly sends out descriptions of the teeth of individuals wanted in connection with federal charges.

There are cases recorded of crimes that were solved by the tooth markings left in materials such as cheese or by bite marks in skin.

TEETH HAVE told us a great deal about early man and the forms of life existing before man. Because they are so hard and durable, teeth have survived many hundreds of centuries and are among the most important sources of our knowledge of man's biological and social history.

When you visit your dentist, your teeth, too, provide much information about yourself. They tell your dentist, by the way they wear and by their position, if they and the jaws are in proper relation, or if corrective action is needed to improve their functioning and preserve their life.

THEY TELL your dentist what your diet is like and how well you do your daily job of good toothbrushing. They provide the information he needs to counsel you wisely for good oral health.

Your dentist also knows from the condition of the soft tissues of the mouth some of the things going on in the rest of your body. The mouth often provides the warning signal for illness developing elsewhere.

For instance, tuberculosis ulcers often appear in the mouth when pulmonary (lung) tuberculosis exists. The pres-

ence of TB ulcers on the palate, tongue or tonsil alerts the dentist to the patient's need for medical treatment.

ORAL EXAMINATION can also help uncover such illnesses as pleurisy, hypertension, leukemia and diabetes. Thyroid conditions and Paget's Disease also have oral symptoms.

Sometimes the clues work in reverse — pains in other parts of the body signal the existence of dental difficulties. Pains in the eye or temple may mean problems in the upper back teeth. Damaged lower molars may be the culprit where pain occurs in neck or head. Malocclusion (faulty bite) and jaw-joint disturbances can cause headaches.

YOUR DENTIST knows the importance of good oral health for the health of the rest of your body. Not only will changes in the body affect the teeth and soft tissues of the mouth, but abnormal functioning of the tissues and organs in the mouth can create serious disturbances in your over-all health.
