MAZATLAN, Mexico — I've run into a number of small yachts in West Coast Mexican ports carrying pickup crews of young people. Boats that sleep six to ten.

But it's a good way to get around for people in the under-25-years bracket.

The way to do it? You go down to the yacht basin and ask around.

Galbraith has taught at the University of California, Harvard and Princeton. He received his Ph.D. in economics from the University of California and was Social Science Research Council Fellow at Cambridge University in 1937-38.

## Plan for School Approved

Final plans for the new \$3.5 million Glenn Hammond Curtiss Junior High School in the Dominguez area have been approved by the Los Angeles City Board of Education.

In addition, the school board authorized the district staff to begin accepting construction bids on the project. Bids will be opened April 11. Superintendent of Schools Jack P. Crowther said the school is expected to open in September, 1969, on a 22.7-acre site near Central Avenue and 500 feet south of Turmont Street.

Designed by the architectural firm of Daniel, Mann, Johnson and Mendenhall, the new school will help prevent overcrowded conditions at neighboring junior high schools.

DEVELOPMENT of some 5,000 homes in the Dominguez area east of Avalon Boulevard will require the new school to provide relief for Carnegie, Peary, and White junior high schools.

Plans call for 30 general classrooms, four art rooms, two typing rooms, four home-making classrooms, four in-

dustrial arts shops, three music rooms and science laboratories.

In addition, the school will feature physical education facilities with 1,200 girls' lockers and 1,200 boys' lockers, a combination gymnasium floor, administrative center, guidance unit, attendance office, health unit, library and student store.
