## Four Win Awards in Contest

Four area students were among top winners in the zone finals of the Bank of America Achievement Awards announced here this week for Los Angeles City School students. Local winners included Daryl O. Deliman, of 5305 Carol Drive, who won first place in the science and mathematics category; Ida Sugita, student at Carson High School, who won second place in vocational arts; Tim McDuffie, 25209 Petroleum Ave., Harbor City, second place in liberal arts; and James Ler, 1106 W. 216th, who won third place in science and mathematics. Deliman, Miss Sugita, and McDuffie are students at Narbonne High School. Ler is a

student at Carson High School. First-place winners are assured of cash awards totaling at least \$150 in the contest and may be eligible for awards of up to \$1,000. Second-place winners were awarded \$50 cash awards, while third-place winners received \$25 in cash.

## Paintings On Exhibit At Home

A gallery of paintings from the All-City Outdoor Art Festival has been set up at the Torrance office of Home Savings and Loan Association, 1511 Cravens Ave.

The outstanding paintings on display include top prize-winning works from the nation's largest outdoor art festival, held every summer in Los Angeles.

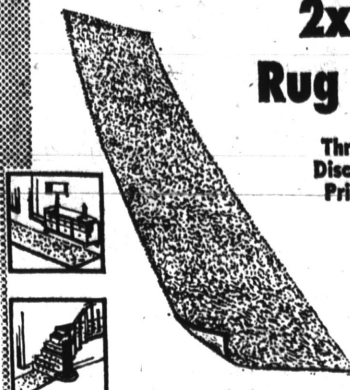
