Soccer Coach From England Became Attracted to Baseball

The Los Angeles Wolves are set for pro soccer action again at the Rose Bowl but a sparkling personality that helped introduce this interna-

tional sport to local fans is missing.

Coach Ronnie Allen, who led the Wolves to a United Soccer Association title for Jack Kent Cooke in '67, is staying home to rebuild his Wolverhampton club. He's replaced by Ray Wood, former Manchester United goalie.

Allen will miss California, an experience he said was simply marvelous. The popular English football coach (soccer) became a dyed-in-the-wool Los Angeles Dodger fan last summer—and grew to love the game of baseball.

"Willie Davis was my favorite," Allen related. "He's my kind of a player. Speedy and quick. Running the bases in daring fashion. He reminded me of many of the outstanding football (soccer)

players in England," Ronnie explained.

Allen also loves all facets of the game of baseball. "The pitch-in (pitcher throwing) was interesting. I liked the way Don Drysdale moved the pitch-in around the batters. Many didn't like the way he threw the pitch-in. Good catchers and good throw-in to the bases were extraordinary," added the popular mentor.

What team impressed you the most, Allen was asked. "St. Louis. They had good balance. The good balance won for them."

March 19, 1968, will go down in history at Pepperdine College as the day a new image was created.

That new image is Gary Colson and his game is basketball.

When Colson took over as head basketball coach at Pepperdine last month there were

a lot of loose ends that had to be tied together.

One was building a winner and the second was finding a team.

The problems were evident because Pepperdine hasn't had a winning season in six years and only one starter returns from last year's 9-17 team.

But Colson is out to change all that and his dynamic personality has created new interest in basketball on the campus.

His record proves he is a winner.

In ten seasons as head basketball coach at Valdost State College in Georgia, Colson won 188 games and lost just 69 for a win percentage of .731.

Immediately after signing his contract with the Waves, Colson boarded a plane to scout the National Junior College Athletic Association tournament in Hutchinson, Kansas.

After that it was a flight to Georgia to see some of the state's top high school talent and then back to Los Angeles to meet some of the southland's best preps.

Continually on the move searching for talent, Colson flew to the San Francisco and Sacramento areas and then took another plane for the Olympic Trial in Albuquerque, New Mexico (April 4-6).

Obviously, enthusiasm is one of Colson's traits.
