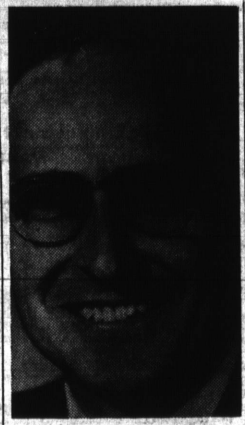
Half of the offering will be sent to the Recording for the Blind organization.

The program will end with a sacrificial lunch. Co-chairmen for the day are Mrs. Sarah Dickens and Mrs. June Betz.

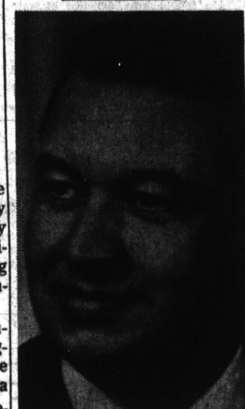

'D for Decency' Week Proclaimed in County

"D for Decency" Week has been proclaimed this week in Los Angeles County.

The week has been set aside to unite opposition to the obscenity and pornography traffic in the county.

"Obscenity and pornography are a national problem which must be checked," Supervisor Burton Chace said. "They are contributing factors to many social problems, including crime and juvenile delinquency."

Supervisors recognized the growing problem of pornography three years ago when they formed the County Commission on Obscenity and Pornography. The 15-member group has helped organize countywide opposition to smut.

Chace urged citizens to participate in the various activities spearheaded by the commission. These include:

- Education of citizens to the growing problem of pornography in this county.
- Support of sound state legislature to correct the problem.

Promotion of worthwhile literature, particularly for young people.

Encourage positive moral and spiritual values in the home.

Work toward a closer association of families with character-building organizations.

Encourage local, county, and state officials to take action against smut producers and distributors.

Cooperation with law enforcement agencies and law

officials in efforts to abate obscene literature and other forms of pornography, including motion pictures.

"This is everyone's problem and one which can be helped more by the individual who is willing to act," Chace said. "I am hopeful many citizens will take a close look at the commission's objectives and then assist in implementing them."
