School to Hold Summer Session

Gardena Christian School will conduct its third annual Summer Enrichment Day Camp program beginning Monday, June 17, through Aug. 23.

The purpose of the Summer Enrichment Program is to provide elementary students with a variety of activities and experiences to broaden their perspective of the world around them. The program makes possible a wholesome, enriching, summer environment for children ages 4½ through 12.

One day each week is Field Trip Day. Students travel via school bus to such places as Marineland, Griffith Park Zoo, Griffith Park Observatory, Knott's Berry Farm, and other places of interest.

On days when students are not traveling, their time is

absorbed in crafts, art, storytime, films, music, supervised recreation (sports and games) and academic help. Remedial grade-level instruction is available upon request in reading and math.

Younger students take a nap after lunch. Most days are concluded with a short Bible Story.

Each teacher is given a maximum of 25 students for supervision. Parents and other adults give additional assistance on field trip days.

The basic hours of the Summer Program are the same as regular school hours, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. However, students who have working parents may come as early as 7 a.m. and stay as late as 6 p.m. with supervised care at no extra charge.

Narcotics Expert To Lecture Here

Sergeant Rick Bergman of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will be the first speaker in a series of public lectures on "Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs" to be held Tuesday evenings at Torrance High School.

Sergeant Bergman will discuss "The National, State and County Problems in the Use of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs" in a talk set for 7:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 7.

Co-sponsors of the four lectures are Torrance Evening Adult School and Torrance Council PTA.

A MEMBER of the Sheriff's Department for 15 years, Sergeant Bergman has served with the Narcotics Bureau for 10 years, six of which have been spent in the South Bay area. He has testified as an expert in the field of narcotics

in federal, superior, and municipal courts in both Los Angeles and San Diego.

He has lectured in almost every college in Southern California on the topic of narcotics.

IN ADDITION, he has written training material for both law enforcement and educational groups on the narcotics problem and has trained personnel from governmental,

military, probation and parole agencies on narcotic investigation and detection techniques. He has also trained members of foreign governmental agencies in overall narcotic background.
