County Shows Progress Toward Highway System

Los Angeles County is making significant progress toward the improvement of its highway system, but unprecedented growth and a public dependency on automobile travel threaten to pose huge demands within the next 10 years.

That statement by Supervisor Burton W. Chace, chairman of the County Road Committee, summarizes a list of 1968 Highway needs submitted to supervisors last week.

Prepared by the County Road Department for the State Division of Highways, the report indicates that significant strides have been taken since the last such study in 1961. Even greater efforts will be necessary, however, if the list of inadequate roads is to be kept to a minimum by 1978, the report said.

"THE STUDY indicates that

County supervisors have purchased a site for construction of a health center to serve the Wilmington area, Supervisor Burton W. Chace announced today.

The board has approved purchase of an unimproved 23,000-square-foot lot at Broad Avenue and N Street for \$44,800.

The center eventually will replace the existing Los Angeles City center at 612 W. E. St.

Working plans for the Wilmington Health Center, which will be a subsidiary of the San Pedro District Health Center, are being prepared by the County Engineer.

County engineers are preparing plans for a \$7,152-square-foot building which will cost approximately \$214,000.
