Lynn's farther is a civil engineer and his mother juggles secretarial duties with piano teaching. He has an older brother and sister, both married, and a younger brother who is also beginning to show promise as a student leader. He's student body president at Meadow Park Elementary School.

As if Lynn didn't have enough to do at school, he picks up spending money by serving summonses for a lawyer. This can be tricky business to hear Lynn tell about it. As a "bearer of bad tidings," Lynn has to be fast on his feet to do this work. But he's got it down to a science.
