It goes out Mission and Valley Boulevard to El Monte, and then through La Puente, Walnut, and Spadra to Pomona. The scenery from La Puente to Pomona is beautiful, giving you a view of nature before the bulldozer took its toll. The trip, one way, takes about an hour and 35 minutes. While in Pomona, visit their new Mall with its shops and stores, have lunch, and return later in the day. The 53 line starts at the RTD station, 6th and Los Angeles, then travels north on Spring Street. Send for a map and plan a do-it-yourself one-day trip.

Q How do I get to the Shrine Auditorium from Redondo Beach? Also to North Primrose Avenue in Alhambra? Mrs. V.A.

A The 51 line operates hourly service, on the hour, from Redondo Beach (Catalina and Avenue I). Take the 51 to Jefferson and transfer or walk west to Figueroa and the Shrine. To go to Primrose, get off the 51 at 7th and Spring and catch the 52 line to Primrose and Main Street in Alhambra.

Q How do I get to 626 Wilshire Boulevard from Palos Verdes Boulevard and Calle Miramar? Mrs. J.L.S.

A The 51 line on Palos Verdes Boulevard will take you to 7th and Olive, where you can transfer to the 83 Wilshire to your address. I'll send you timetables and a map.

Q Please tell me how to get to the Coliseum and Dodger Stadium from Harbor City.

A RTD does not serve that area. Take the Gardena 4 line to downtown Gardena and change to their 1 line to Santa Barbara and Main. Walk 2 blocks west and catch the 5 line to the Coliseum. For Dodger Stadium, ride the Gardena 1 line to 6th and Main, walk one block west to Spring and catch the 177 to the Stadium. I'll send you all necessary timetables for RTD.

Q I live on Pennsylvania Avenue in Lomita. Is there any place near my home I could take a bus directly to Los Angeles? I've been going into San Pedro. R.M.

A Seems to me, it would be easier to catch the 37 line on Avalon and Lomita, or take the Greyhound local to Wilmington, if their schedule works out. You're in an area with limited bus service. Wish I could help you.

'No Smoking, No Fires' Signs Posted in County

"No Smoking—No Fires" signs have been posted throughout the brush covered areas of Los Angeles County because of increasing high fire danger. County Fire Chief Keith E. Klinger announced today.

All areas served by the County Fire Department which are posted are "closed areas" and smoking and open

fires of all kinds are prohibited by ordinance. "Because of the early end of our winter rains, the hillsides are becoming dangerously dry," Chief Klinger said. "The unseasonal hot, dry winds during Easter week quickly reduced the moisture content of the brush." In areas where the "No Smoking" signs have been posted, smoking is prohibited in cars, on horseback, and in all places except those of habitation and those posted as "safe smoking areas." "Last year's disastrous brush fires burned more than 10,000 acres throughout Los Angeles County. More than 50 homes and other buildings were damaged or destroyed during these fires," the chief commented.
