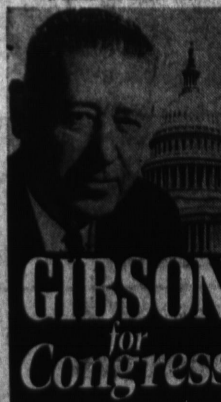
Neighbor Reports Burglary

Campaign Breakfast Held Here
