Work Scheduled Bids will be opened March 5 for widening of a three-quarter-mile stretch of West-ern Avenue in the Palos Vert-des-San Pedro area, Super-visor Burton W, Chace an S. John Montgomery Non S. John Mon

nounced today The Board of Supervisors approved plans and specifica

tions yesterday before calling for bids. The project will be between Palos Verdes Drive North and Redondela Drive. Work on Western Avenue will include widening and paving and installation of curbs, gutters, and a raised center median divider. The road will be reconstructed to lanes with left turn channels.

"COMPLETION of this project is expected by July if no complications arise," Chace said. "The program is part of a multi-staged improvement of 10 miles of Western Avenue between the San Diego Freeway in Torrance and 25th Street in San Pedro.'

Chace pointed out that the county recently approved a joint agreement with Los Angeles, Torrance, Lomita, and the state for the over-all proj-ect. The contract provides that the state will pay half the construction costs. "Western Avenue is a ma-

jor north-south artery stretch-ing from Griffith Park in Los Angeles to the Palos Verdes Peninsula," Chace said. "The completed work will increase the safety factor and provide for a traffic capacity of 32,000 vehicles a day."
