Anderson **Makes Bid** For Seat

Glenn M. Anderson, a Dem ocrat and former lieutenant governor of California, has announced he will seek the 17th Congressional District seat being vacated by Congressman Cocil R. King.

King, who has served since August 25, 1942, announced last week he will not seek re-election this year.

Anderson, now engaged in the home construction business, was elected mayor of Hawthorne in his first successful political campaign. Elected to that office at the age of 27, Anderson was then the youngest mayor in the nation.

He resigned as mayor of Hawthorne after being elected to the Assembly in the 46th Assembly District in 1942. He was re-elected in 1944, 1946, and 1948.

ANDERSON was elected lieutenant governor in the 1958 general election and was re-elected in 1962.


