

Assembly Hearings Planned

The State Assembly Committee on Natural Resources will hold public hearings in Torrance Friday and Saturday on the problem of disposal of solid wastes.

The hearings, arranged by Assemblyman L. E. (Larry) Townsend (D-Torrance), are the first of several sessions to be held throughout the state.

The committee is headed by Edwin L. Z'berg (D-Sacramento).

Purpose of the hearings is to investigate several proposed methods for disposing of solid wastes. Those proposals include dumping wastes into the ocean, a methane gas disposal system, and trucking wastes to distant points for disposal.

The committee expects to hear from businessmen involved in the waste disposal business during the two-day hearings. Sessions are scheduled for 10 a.m. both mornings in the City Council chambers at the Torrance City Hall.

Youngster Injured in Alley Crash

One-year-old David Lee McClintock received a deep gash over his left eye Monday after he was struck by a car. The mishap occurred in an alley behind his apartment house, 23611 Arlington Ave.

The California State Department of Employment today announced plans to reopen the Torrance Farm Labor Office effective tomorrow.

The office, to be located at 1314 Cravens Ave., will be operated as a branch of the Santa Ana Farm Labor Office. It will serve the area south of Imperial Highway and east of the Santa Ana River.

Ben Garcia will manage the Torrance office. Office hours will be from 7 a.m. to noon during the week.
