

Security Pacific Bank State's Second Largest

Official formation of Security Pacific National Bank as a statewide banking institution was announced this week with the merger of Security First National Bank and Pacific National Bank of San Francisco. The merger creates the second largest statewide bank in California. A total of 366 branches are open and the new institution has assets in excess of \$5.75 billion.

Frederick G. Larkin Jr., president of Security First National Bank, is president and chief executive officer of Security Pacific. Carl K. Schieck, former president of Pacific National, becomes executive vice president and administrator for Security Pacific's Northern California headquarters. Signs will be replaced at all branches gradually. Security First National Bank was formed in 1929 with the merger of Security Trust and Savings Bank and the Los Angeles National Bank.

Governor Vetoes Bill On Marshals

SACRAMENTO—Governor Ronald Reagan announced he has vetoed AB 470, by Assemblyman Walter J. Karabian (D-Monterey Park), which provided that the marshal in Los Angeles and San Diego counties have sole responsibility to serve civil processes.

Reagan said he vetoed the measure because operation of the sheriff's and marshal's department is primarily a matter of local concern. He said the bill deprived local government of its "inherent right to manage its own affairs."
