Several rare and interesting animals have been added to our own Los Angeles Zoo for your viewing pleasure. A. The 84 line on Western will take you to Jefferson, where you can transfer east to the school.

Q. How late does the 51 line go from Inglewood to Redondo Beach? I would like to go to the Forum, if I can get home. Mr. D.F.

A. The 51 line runs late enough, 1:06 a.m., but the 54 line is your problem. If you can get over to the 51 line, you're set.

Q. Please send me your map and tell me how to go to Marineland from Hermosa Beach. I've been told such service exists. Mrs. G.K.

A. Your information is correct. You can get the 125 line in Hermosa Beach at 9:39 a.m. (Pier and Artesia) and arrive Marineland 10:20 a.m. Return 3:30 p.m. This is good 7 days a week.

Q. Can you tell me where the Federal Building is in Los Angeles and how I can get there by bus. I live in Gardena, near Redondo Beach Boulevard. Mr. A.B.

A. The Gardena Municipal Lines #1 bus will take you to 6th and Main Street in Los Angeles. From there take a 2 or 8 bus to Temple Street and walk one block east.
