

Freeway Route Set

SACRAMENTO—Members of the State Highway Commission meeting in San Diego Wednesday settled the controversial Century Freeway in Los Angeles by adopting a route for 8.9 miles of the route over eight alternates.

The adopted line begins at Central Avenue, and runs easterly near Imperial Highway, which marks the boundary between the city and county of Los Angeles. It then follows the Pacific Electric tracks through Lynwood, and continues on to Interstate Route 605 via a southerly location in Downey.

It is estimated that the freeway will cost in excess of \$100 million for acquisition of rights-of-way and construction.

The Century Freeway was placed in the interstate system for mileage previously deleted in San Francisco. Its overall length is approximately 17 miles, and the cost of the entire route is estimated at more than \$250 million. Termini of the freeway, Interstate 105, are Sepulveda Boulevard near the Los Angeles Airport, and Interstate 605 in Norwalk.

Legislature Repeals Trailer Parking Law

Two pieces of urgency legislation which make life a little easier for owners of campers are now effective, 870 at June 30, 1968, against \$84,091,425 a year earlier. California Highway Patrol Commissioner H. W. Sullivan has announced.

The controversial section of the vehicle code which since Nov. 8, 1967, made it illegal to park any trailer coach, housecar or vehicle equipped with a camper upon any highway during hours of darkness has been repealed. The law was never

enforced, since the legislature indicated its intention to repeal it in a resolution passed last year. Repeal of this section does not affect other sections of the law dealing with parking of motor vehicles.

THE SECOND bill, AB835

by Assemblyman John Foran, defines a three-axle housecar, permits it to operate at speed limits that apply to passenger vehicles, and makes it possible for holders of regular driver's licenses to drive such a vehicle.
