# Hearing on RTD Plans Scheduled

A continued public hearing on Southern California Rapid Transit District's Final Report will be held at 10:30 a.m. next Tuesday. RTD President Don C. McMillan said the hearing, to be held in the district's second floor board room, 1060 S. Broadway, Los Angeles, is open to all interested citizens along with city and county officials.

Conducted as part of the process leading to adoption—later in August—of first-stage rapid transit routes, the public hearing concerns the final report recommendations for first and second stage rapid transit lines, as well as new and expanded bus services.

Los Angeles County residents will vote Nov. 5 on funding the first stage Rapid Transit lines, second stage rapid transit engineering, and implementing new and expanded bus services.
