

Townsend Names Aides For Re-election Drive

Twenty-four municipal officials, educators, and prominent civic leaders have been appointed by Assemblyman L. E. (Larry) Townsend (D-Torrance) to direct the efforts of "The Committee of One Thousand" working for his re-election to the Assembly in November.

Townsend said he was gratified by the results of the June primary election which gave him a 3-1 margin over his opponent and again expressed "humble and sincere thanks to the voters for their confidence."

Named co-chairmen of the committee in Redondo Beach were city councilmen David Hayward and Rodney Neilson.

Reagan Signs Tax Relief Bill for Movie Studios

Legislation authored by Senator Ralph C. Dills (D-Gardena) to give relief from property tax on raw film inventories to the motion picture industry has been signed by Governor Ronald Reagan.

In signing the measure, Governor Reagan said, "I am happy to sign what I consider a constructive

measure that will improve our business climate and add to employment. "The tax should never have been imposed in the first place, and in truth is a

holdover from an era when 'movies' were considered fair game, rich enough to bear almost any injustice."

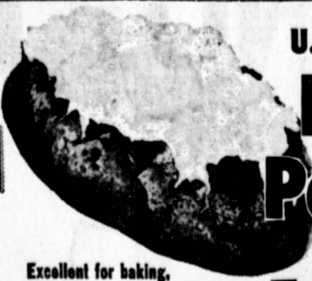
Senator Dills pointed out that studio employment reaches its peak every January, then drops off sharply as production is curtailed until after the March tax date.

Since the tax applies only to California production, the veteran legislator said that for five months each year producers make films in other states and foreign countries.
