Airman 1/C Danny Shor, son of Barney Shor of 5504 Norton St., is on duty at Cam Ranh Bay AB, Vietnam.

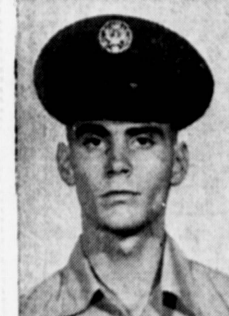
