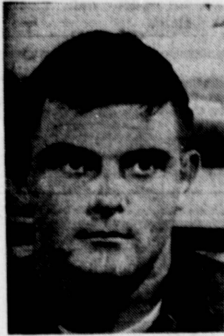


# Armed Forces

His unit, from the 5th Infantry Division at Ft. Carson, Colo., is Company A, 1st Battalion of the division's 61st Infantry.

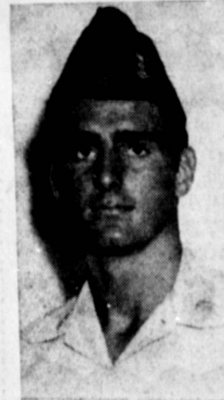
Corporal Charter entered the Army in March, 1967, and completed basic training at Ft. Lewis, Wash.
