Tropical Display Highlights Fair

Been waiting to take that trip to your own tropical paradise? You may not have to go very far this year.

The Los Angeles County Fair's 1968 Flower and Garden Show will be highlighted by its display of tropical and color plants throughout the fair's 17-day run, Sept. 13 through 29.

The show's famous waterfall and reflecting pool will be covered with tropical ferns, orchids and birds of paradise—familiar sights on any South Sea isle. In the pool itself floating baskets of flowers will add a further tropical air.

More color will be added

to the five-acre exhibit by floral displays on the show's hilltop back yard. Beginning at the top, a rose garden will add a wide variety of color. Farther down the hill a green house, Japanese gardens, and an exhibit of hanging baskets will further express the show's emphasis on tropical plants and flowers.

More water will be added to the picture by a swimming pool and domestic garden display also located behind the exhibit's main building.

In all, a total of 32 different classes of plants and flowers will be arranged throughout the exhibit in three different areas of competition: amateurs, juniors (exhibitors under 18 years of age), and commercial growers.

Security Bank Will Finance School Bond

Security Pacific National Bank will finance a \$4.8 million bond issue for the South Bay Union High School District, Redondo Beach.

Security offered the lowest interest rate, one of 4.47 per cent, in bidding Aug. 27 before the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. The second lowest of three bids submitted was 4.55 per cent.

The general purpose school bonds will mature from Oct. 1, 1969, through Oct. 1, 1988. They will be reoffered at yields ranging from 3.20 per cent in 1969 to 4.50 per cent in 1988.

Hospital Will Hire The Poor

South Bay Hospital has joined hundreds of other employer in the greater Los Angeles area in supporting the National Alliance of Businessmen in their effort to place thousands of hard-core unemployed persons in industry and private business.

At a recent board meeting, upon recommendation of Arthur Millers, administrator, South Bay Hospital "pledges to employ 1 per cent of their total work force in any one year from among the hard-core unemployed as it may be feasible to do so." Over 3,000 pledges have been obtained by firms in the Long Beach-Compton-South Bay area, 400 of such being made by South Bay employers.

Lighting Contract Awarded

A contract has been awarded to Steiny & Mitchell, Inc., of Los Angeles for installing traffic signals and highway safety lighting at the intersection of Torrance Boulevard with Catalina Street and the Victoria

Street-Tamcliff Avenue intersection.

Four bids were received ranging from a high of \$16,851 to the awarded low bid of \$15,129.

The installations are slated for completion in December. Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said part of the Victoria

Street - Tamcliff Avenue project is within the city of Carson, which will contribute a proportionate share of the cost of installing the signals at this intersection. Torrance Boulevard carries a daily average of 15,200 vehicles across Catalina Street.
