Petitions Seek to Place McCarthy on State Ballot

Californians for an Alternative in November (CAN) will distribute more than 2,000 petitions in the Torrance area this week in an effort to qualify Sen. Eugene McCarthy (D-Minn.) for the Presidential ballot Nov. 5.

John Barton, Torrance area chairman, said petitions may be obtained at 2368 W. Torrance Blvd., 314 Vista del Mar in the Riviera Village, an apt 726 Anaheim St., Wilmington.

Some 330,000 signatures must be obtained by Sept. 20 in order to qualify an independent slate of electors pledged to Senator McCarthy for the ballot.

Barton said any registered voter may sign the petitions without a change of registration, Barton pointed out.

Climax of the week-long effort is scheduled Friday when some 50 neighborhood centers will be opened to the public to sign petitions and raise funds for the campaign.
