

DELINQUENT TAX LIST 1968

Delinquent tax list in and for the County of Los Angeles, State of California. I, HAROLD J. OSTLY, Tax Collector of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, being first duly sworn on oath, say to the best of my knowledge and belief, that the total amount due for taxes, assessments and other charges levied in the year 1967 for the fiscal year 1967-68 were unpaid as of June 30, 1968 on the real property shown on the attached list. This property, except that portion previously sold to the State and not redeemed, was on the amount of sale sold to the State of California on June 28, 1968. The amount shown in dollars and cents opposite the description of the property is the amount for which it was sold to the State. Such real property may be redeemed by the payment of the amount of sale taxes together with such additional penalties and fees as prescribed by law, or may be redeemed under an installment plan of redemption as the Office of the Tax Collector at 225 North Hill Street, Los Angeles, California 90012.

The "name" which precedes each parcel number refers to the name of the assessor. Where no name appears, the name is the same as that of the last assessor above shown.
