## Story of Increased Benefits Approved Job Center Featured

"The SCROC Story," a slide presentation depicting the operations at the Southern California Regional Occupational Center, will be featured at a luncheon meeting of the South Bay-Harbor Industry-Education Council tomorrow.

The noon meeting at the Indian Village Restaurant is open to all persons interested in promoting cooperation between industry and the education community, according to Haig Marshlian, president.

Nearly 2 million service-disabled veterans will receive increased compensation payments beginning next Jan. 1 under a bill signed into law Aug. 19 by President Lyndon Johnson, according to Mort Webster, manager of VA's Southern California regional office.

Some 112,000 veterans with 100 per cent service-connected disabilities will be increased from \$300 to \$400 a month. 1,840,000 veterans with service-connected disabilities rated 10 to 90 per cent will have their payments increased eight per cent.

Passed unanimously by the House June 6 and by the Senate Aug. 2, the new law authorizes the VA to provide invalid lifts, other therapeutic or rehabilitative devices and medical equipment and supplies to eligible veterans. This provision became effective when the bill was signed.

**INCREASED** compensation rates were recommended by the U.S. Veterans Advisory Commission appointed last year at the direction of the President "to conduct a comprehensive study of the pension, compensation and benefits system for veterans, their families and their survivors . . . to assure that our tax dollars are being utilized
