

In an effort to recruit more than 250 new Deputies, Sheriff Peter J. Pitchess has arranged special Saturday testing programs, Oct. 19 and 26 and Nov. 2.

**County Okays Storm Drain Allocations**

The County Flood Control District has been authorized to apply for \$1.2 million in federal funds to help finance a Redondo Beach-Torrance storm drain complex, Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today.

Supervisors gave the go-ahead to the district to seek funds which will be used in construction of the two projects.

Chace said the application will be filed with the Department of Housing and Urban Development. If approved, funds would be forthcoming under provisions of the federal Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965.

The drainage system will serve an area bounded by Artesia Boulevard on the north, Hawthorne Boulevard on the east, Torrance Boulevard on the south, and the Pacific Ocean on the west.
