## Terminal Island Freeway Route Now Under Study

The California Highway Commission Monday took under consideration the adoption of a freeway location for approximately eight miles of Route 47 (Terminal Island Freeway in Los Angeles County.

It begins at the north approach to the Heim Bridge which leads to Terminal Island and ends at the adopted location for the Route 91 Freeway in a newly annexed area of Compton.

Director of Public Works James A. Moe has recommended a route which runs northwesterly along the alignment of the Terminal Island Freeway to south of Sepulveda Boulevard at the western border of Long Beach. It then swings northwesterly to cross the San Diego Freeway west of Alameda Street, turning again to run roughly parallel to

Alameda Street to just south of Del Amo Boulevard.

AT THIS point it assumes a general northerly direction to the future Route 91 Freeway at Artesia Boulevard.

This routing was identified as the "green" alternate at a public hearing conducted by the Division of Highways in the Wilmington area last May 29.

In making his recommendation, Moe told the commission that this alignment is supported by Long Beach, the Port of Long Beach, the planning departments of Long Beach and Los Angeles, the Condon Planning Commission, and the Long Beach and Dominguez Chambers of Commerce.

HE ADDED that it affects fewer single-family residences than the other alternate that was studied in detail and is \$16,400,000 lower in cost.

## Beverly on Tour for Nixon-Agnew Campaign

"The one simple but overriding factor of this presidential campaign is that Hubert Humphrey, and certainly George Wallace, could not govern this nation even if elected. The in-fighting in the Democratic Party is so bad that perhaps they should adopt the piranha as their party emblem to replace the donkey."

This was the message carried today by Assemblyman Robert G. Beverly (R-Manhattan Beach), member of the Nixon-Agnew Media Relations Committee. Beverly was joined by Assemblyman William Bagley (R-San Rafael) and Senator Fred W. Marler (R-Redding) as they traveled throughout Northern California visiting editors, political writers, and radio and television stations. In joint remarks Beverly and Marler stated, "The Humphrey leadership of the Democratic Party is so

fraught with fratricide that he simply is not in a position to re-establish a national purpose and thus to mend the social fabric of this nation. The disenchantment, disillusionment and outright disengagement of both Southern Democrats and Democrats, comprising more than 50 per cent of the party, would continue to haunt Hubert Humphrey long after the November elections.

"George Wallace is simply a spoiler. His objective now is to wreck the system and he would wreak havoc upon the nation if allowed.

"Dick Nixon, then, rises a tower of strength and solidarity, able to provide the united leadership we so desperately need."

Beverly, Bagley, and Marler are in their fourth week of travel throughout California on behalf of Nixon-Agnew. They will visit Marysville, Yuba City, Oroville, Chico, Red Bluff, and Redding and will swing down the Northern coast from Eureka to Vallejo on a two-day tour.
