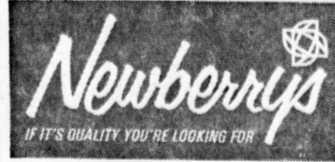
The coffee and social hour was attended by approximately 60 women, many of them new members recently arrived from different parts of the United States.
