• Prepared fish: Sliced, smoked salmon, canned baby shrimp.

• Fruits to garnish: Thinly sliced apples (dipped in lemon juice), fresh grapes,

dried prunes, or other fruits in season.

• Vegetables to garnish: parsley, onion rings, radishes, cucumber, dill sprig, tomatoes.

• Also: Olives, caviar, sliced hard-cooked egg, pickles, mushrooms.

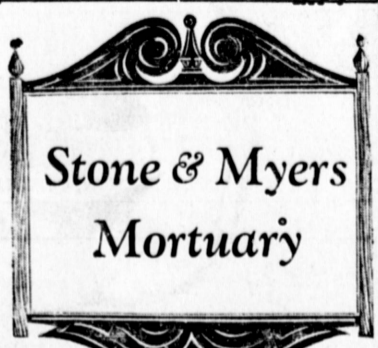
